**NOTICE TO THE MARKET
NEW STAGE OF THE INVESTMENT PROGRAM IN LOGISTICS**

Arteris S.A. hereby informs its shareholders and the market in general that, as announced yesterday in a ceremony at the Presidential Building, the Federal Government launched the **New Stage of the Investment Program in Logistics (PIL)**, continuing the modernization process of Brazil's transport infrastructure, consolidating even more Brazil's highway concession model.

Out of the investments expected, totaling more than R\$66 billion for the highway modal, in addition to new concessions, the government expects to make additional investments in existing concessions.

According to yesterday's announcement, four highway auctions are expected for 2015, and 11 in 2016. Additionally, two new construction projects (amendments) are in progress and nine are being evaluated.

Arteris, whose mission is to play a major role in the development of the infrastructure necessary for Brazil's sustainable growth, managing highway concessions with a long-term vision, will assess all market opportunities as the projects are detailed.

Regarding the potential amendments, four of them relate to highways under the Company's concession and will be assessed jointly with the granting authority. Some of these works are under feasibility study or project elaboration phase, namely:
